NRC NAMES NEW RESIDENT INSPECTOR AT D.C. COOK NUCLEAR POWER PLANT

Nuclear Regulatory Commission officials in Lisle, Illinois, have announced the assignment of Kevin A. Coyne as the agency's resident inspector at the D.C. Cook nuclear power plant in Stevensville, Michigan.

Prior to joining the NRC's Region III staff in October, Coyne was a project engineer for the NRC in its Region 2 office which is located in Atlanta, Georgia. Before joining the NRC, he was a shift test engineer at the Norfolk Naval Shipyard in Norfolk, Virginia.
