The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has received four reports from its Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards following the Committee's meetings April 7-10 and May 5-8. The reports provide comments on:

- The safety aspects of the Baltimore Gas and Electric Company's license renewal application for the Calvert Cliffs nuclear power plant, Units 1 and 2 (interim letter);
- Modifications proposed by the Westinghouse Owners Group to the core damage assessment guidelines and post accident sampling system requirements;
- Proposed resolution of generic safety issue-165, spring-actuated safety and relief valve reliability.
