NRC TO SOLICIT COMMENTS ON NUCLEAR PLANT DECOMMISSIONING DOCUMENT

Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff, at a public meeting in Boston next Wednesday, will solicit comments on its intention to prepare a "Draft Supplement to the Generic Environmental Impact Statement on Decommissioning of Nuclear Facilities."

The meeting is scheduled for 7 to 10 p.m. at the Boston Marriott, Copley Place, 110 Huntington Avenue, Boston.

The session is one of four being held around the country regarding the Draft Supplement. Although a 1988 NRC document, NUREG-0586, "Generic Environmental Impact Statement (GEIS) on Decommissioning Nuclear Facilities," covered all NRC-licensed facilities, the supplement would address only the decommissioning of nuclear power reactors.

NRC staff plans to issue the Draft Supplement for public comment next year.

The meeting will include a presentation by the NRC staff on the reasons a supplement to the GEIS is being prepared and the environmental issues related to the decommissioning of nuclear plants it will address.
