NRC TO MEET WITH PROGRESS ENERGY/CP&L OFFICIALS TO DISCUSS SAFETY PERFORMANCE AT BRUNSWICK NUCLEAR POWER PLANT

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will meet with Progress Energy/CP&L officials on Tuesday, June 26, to discuss the results of NRC's annual assessment of safety performance at the Brunswick nuclear power plant.

The meeting will be held at 12:00 noon in the Brunswick Technical Training Center Auditorium at the plant site near Southport, North Carolina. The public is invited to observe the meeting. NRC officials will be available after the meeting to answer questions. The NRC will hold a second meeting with state and local government officials after the first meeting. That second meeting is also open to the public.
