NRC APPOINTS JEFFREY CRUZ RESIDENT INSPECTOR AT WOLF CREEK

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission has appointed Jeffrey Cruz resident inspector at Wolf Creek Generation Station, a nuclear power plant near Burlington, Kansas. He joins senior resident inspector Frank Brush.

Mr. Cruz holds a master's degree in nuclear engineering with emphasis in health physics from the University of Missouri in 1994. He earned a bachelor's degree in general studies with emphasis in mathematics in 1991, also from the University of Missouri.
