NRC TO MEET WITH EXELON GENERATION COMPANY TO DISCUSS SAFETY PERFORMANCE AT THE CLINTON NUCLEAR PLANT

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission will meet with Exelon Generation Company officials July 13 to discuss the NRC's annual assessment of safety performance at the Clinton Power Station near Clinton, Illinois.

The meeting will begin at 9 a.m. CDT and will be held in the plant's Energy and Environmental Center on Route 54, six miles east of Clinton. The public is invited to observe the session. NRC officials will be available afterwards to answer questions.

The annual assessment, referred to as the End-of-Cycle assessment, evaluates safety performance at the Clinton plant from April 2000 through March 2001, and informs plant officials of the NRC's plans for future inspections at the facility.
