NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON NUCLEAR WASTE TO MEET MARCH 19 -21 IN ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Nuclear Waste (ACNW) has scheduled a meeting on March 19 - 21 in Rockville, Maryland, to discuss, among other subjects, a presentation by the Department of Energy that updates its recent performance assessment activities for the proposed high-level nuclear waste repository at Yucca Mountain, Nevada.
