NRC TO MEET WITH EXELON MARCH 18 TO DISCUSS CLINTON NUCLEAR PLANT PERFORMANCE

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will meet with representatives of Exelon Generating Company in Clinton, Illinois, on Monday, March 18, to discuss the results of the agency's annual assessment of safety performance at the Clinton Nuclear Power Plant. The facility is located near Clinton.

The meeting, which will be the open to the public for observation, is scheduled to begin at 10 a.m. in the Vespasian Warner Public Library, 310 N. Quincy St., Clinton. Before the meeting is concluded, NRC officials will answer any questions from members of the public.

The performance period to be discussed is April 1 through December 31 of last year.
