NRC TO MEET WITH OPPD TO DISCUSS SAFETY PERFORMANCE AT FORT CALHOUN

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will meet with representatives of Omaha Public Power District on Tuesday, March 26, to discuss the results of the agency's annual assessment of safety performance at the Fort Calhoun Station nuclear power plant. The facility is located near Blair, Nebraska, and is operated by OPPD.

The meeting, which will be the open to the public for observation, is scheduled to begin at 7 p.m. at Dana Hall of Science, Dana College, 2848 College Dr., Blair. NRC staff will be available before the meeting is adjourned to answer any questions from the public.
