NRC TO MEET WITH STP NUCLEAR OPERATING COMPANY TO DISCUSS SAFETY PERFORMANCE AT SOUTH TEXAS PROJECT

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will meet with representatives of STP Nuclear Operating Company on Monday, April 1, to discuss the results of the agency's annual assessment of safety performance at the South Texas Project nuclear power plant. The facility, which has two operating reactors, is located near Bay City, Texas, and is operated by STP Nuclear Operating Company.

The meeting, which will be open to the public for observation, is scheduled to begin at 6 p.m. at the Bay City Convention Center, 201 Seventh St., Bay City. NRC staff will be available before the meeting is adjourned to answer any questions from the public.
