NRC TO MEET WITH ENERGY NORTHWEST TO DISCUSS SAFETY PERFORMANCE AT COLUMBIA GENERATING STATION

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will meet with representatives of Energy Northwest on Wednesday, April 10, to discuss the results of the agency's annual assessment of safety performance at the Columbia Generating Station nuclear power plant. The facility is located near Richland, Wa., and is operated by Energy Northwest.

The meeting, which will be open to the public for observation, is scheduled to begin at 6:30 p.m. at the Richland Public Library, 955 Northgate Dr., Richland. NRC staff will be available before the meeting is adjourned to answer any questions from the public.
