NRC TO HOLD 15TH ANNUAL REGULATORY INFORMATION CONFERENCE APRIL 16 - 18 IN WASHINGTON, D.C.

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will hold its 15th annual Regulatory Information Conference from Wednesday, April 16, to Friday, April 18, at the Capital Hilton Hotel, 16th and K Streets, NW, Washington, DC. The conference will open at 9:00 a.m. Wednesday and at 8:00 a.m. Thursday and Friday. There is no conference fee and the sessions will be open to the public.
