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NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS TO MEET OCT. 7-9 IN ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards will hold a public meeting Oct. 7-9, in Rockville, Md., to discuss an evaluation of industry guidelines related to the performance of sumps, a component of the safety-related recirculation system in some nuclear power plants.

In addition, the committee will discuss the NRC staff's pre-application safety assessment for the ACR-700 nuclear plant design, among other things.

The meeting will be held in Room T-2B3 of the agency's Two White Flint North building, at 11545 Rockville Pike. It will begin at 8:30 a.m. each day and all sessions will be open to the public.
