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NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS TO MEET DEC. 2-4 IN ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards will hold a public meeting Dec. 2-4, in Rockville, Md., to discuss, among other items, a preliminary document on a method for estimating the possibility of loss-of-coolant accidents at nuclear power plants. The committee will also discuss a proposed change to NRC regulations to use more risk insights into emergency core cooling systems for nuclear power reactors.

The meeting will be held in Room T-2B3 of the agency's Two White Flint North building, at 11545 Rockville Pike. Open portions are scheduled from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Thursday; 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Friday; and 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, although some portions of the Saturday morning session may be closed to the public for security reasons.
