NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS TO MEET APRIL 7-9 IN ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards will hold a public meeting April 7-9 in Rockville, Md., where, among other items, members will meet with the NRC Commissioners to discuss several regulatory and technical issues. Committee members will also discuss the final safety evaluation report on the license renewal application for the Joseph M. Farley Nuclear Plant in Alabama, the NRC's program for analyzing significant events and standardized models for analyzing plant risk.

The meeting will run from 8:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. on Thursday and Friday, and from 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturday. All sessions will be held in Room T-2B3 of the agency's Two White Flint North building at 11545 Rockville Pike, except the meeting with the NRC Commissioners, which will take place from 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Thursday in the Commissioners Conference Room in One White Flint North.
