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NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS TO MEET MAY 5-6 IN ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards will hold a public meeting May 5-6 in Rockville, Md., to discuss, among other items, the final review of the license renewal application and final Safety Evaluation Report for Arkansas Nuclear One, Unit 2. The committee will also be briefed on the status of Department of Energy plans, research, and development activities related to advanced reactor designs for hydrogen production, and discuss the objectives, technical approach and results of the steam generator tube integrity program being conducted by the Argonne National Laboratory.

The meeting will be held in Room T-2B3 of the agency's Two White Flint North building, at 11545 Rockville Pike. The meeting will begin at 8:30 a.m. both days and end at 6:45 p.m. on Thursday and 7 p.m. on Friday.
