## **NRC MEETING MARCH 25 IN ROCKVILLE, MD., TO DISCUSS PROPOSED REVISION TO RESEARCH REACTOR LICENSE RENEWAL**

Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will conduct a public meeting at the agency headquarters in Rockville, Md., on Wednesday, March 25, to discuss proposed near-term revisions to the review process for renewing research and test reactor (RTR) operating licenses.

The agency is working to resolve a backlog of RTR license renewal requests, and the staff is proposing interim changes to promptly resolve the backlog while maintaining safety standards. The meeting is part of the staff's effort to work with the RTR community and the public to determine the most appropriate short-term changes.

The NRC will hold the meeting from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. in Room O13G4 of the NRC's One White Flint North building at 11555 Rockville Pike in Rockville. A teleconference line will also be available for members of the public to call in.
