NRC NAMES NEW SENIOR RESIDENT INSPECTOR AT NINE MILE POINT NUCLEAR PLANT



Nuclear Regulatory Commission officials in the Region I office in King of Prussia, Pa., have selected Kenneth Kolaczyk as the Senior Resident Inspector at the Nine Mile Point nuclear power plant in Scriba, N.Y. He joins Resident Inspector Doug Dempsey at the two-unit site operated by Constellation Energy.

“Ken Kolaczyk has the experience and commitment to safety that will help the NRC ensure that Nine Mile Point conducts operations with the highest safety standards to protect the public health and safety,” said acting NRC Region I Administrator Marc L. Dapas.

Kolaczyk joined the NRC’s Region I office in 1988. During his tenure, he has served as a Resident Inspector at Millstone Station and a Senior Resident Inspector at R.E. Ginna. He has also worked as a specialist inspector in the Region’s Division of Reactor Safety, as a reactor engineer and licensed operator examiner.

Prior to his NRC service, Kolaczyk worked as a nuclear shift test supervisor at Norfolk Naval Shipyard in Portsmouth, Va. He was recently selected to the rank of Captain in the Naval Reserves, where he drills with a Military Sealift Command Unit located at the Navy Yard in Washington, D.C. He is active in local government in his hometown of Victor, N.Y., and serves on several committees including the Conservation Board and Fiscal Responsibility Task Force.

Kolaczyk earned a bachelor’s of engineering degree from the Massachusetts Maritime Academy, a master’s of business administration from Pennsylvania State University and a master’s of public administration from the University of Pennsylvania. He has also graduated from the Naval War College in Newport, R.I., with a diploma in military science.

Each U.S. commercial nuclear power plant has at least two NRC resident inspectors. They serve as the agency's eyes and ears at the facility, conducting regular inspections and monitoring significant work projects.
