NRC TO MEET WITH ENERGY NORTHWEST TO DISCUSS COLUMBIA GENERATING STATION

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will meet with Energy Northwest officials on Oct 15 to discuss performance improvement initiatives for the Columbia Generating Station located near Richland, Wash.

The meeting is open to public observation and will begin at 1 p.m. in the NRC's Region IV office at 1600 E. Lamar Blvd., in Arlington, Texas. Members of the public will have an opportunity to ask questions or make comments after the business portion of the meeting is concluded.

NRC officials and Energy Northwest officials will discuss licensee initiatives and progress in improving human performance at the plant.
