## NRC ANNOUNCES INTERNATIONAL REGULATORS CONFERENCE ON NUCLEAR SECURITY, DEC. 4-6, 2012

Registration for the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's <u>International Regulators</u> <u>Conference on Nuclear Security</u> in Rockville, Md., closes Nov. 9. Anyone wishing to attend, including media, must register online at <u>www.nrcsecurityconference.org</u>.

The conference is a direct result of the 2012 Nuclear Security Summit in Seoul, South Korea. The NRC will welcome the international community Dec. 4-6 to join the discussion on global nuclear security while solidifying relationships among regulatory agencies worldwide.

Keynote speakers will include Yukiya Amano, director general of the International Atomic Energy Agency; John O. Brennan, assistant to President Obama for homeland security and counterterrorism; Ambassador Glyn T. Davies, U.S. special representative for North Korea policy; Mark Weatherford, deputy undersecretary for cyber security at the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.

The conference will be held at the Hilton Washington DC/Rockville Hotel & Executive Meeting Center, 1750 Rockville Pike, in Rockville, Md., on Dec. 4-6.
