Online Registration Closes May 31 for Fuel Cycle Information Exchange, June 11-12, 2013 in Rockville, Md.

Online registration remains open until May 31 for the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's 8th Annual Fuel Cycle Information Exchange (FCIX), to be held June 11-12 at the agency's headquarters in Rockville, Md. Onsite registration will be available both days of the conference.

NRC Chairman Allison Macfarlane will deliver a keynote address on June 11. Bill Borchardt, NRC executive director for operations (EDO), will deliver an executive address the same day. The program for July 12 includes a presentation on the cumulative effects of regulation from Mike Weber, deputy EDO for materials, waste, research, state, tribal and compliance programs. Additional topics to be covered at the conference include post-Fukushima activities, operating experience, security and new construction.

The FCIX will run from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day in the NRC Auditorium (note the meeting is now scheduled to end one hour earlier than previously planned). Visitors will need to enter at the agency's One White Flint North building, 11555 Rockville Pike, in Rockville.
