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NRC Public Meeting Aug. 28 to Receive Comments on Decommissioning Activities Report for TMI-2

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will hold a public meeting Aug. 28 in Hershey, Pa., to discuss the Post-Shutdown Decommissioning Activities Report for Three Mile Island, Unit 2. The public will also be able to make comments.

TMI-2 is a pressurized water reactor located in Londonderry Township, Pa. It has been permanently shut down since the <u>accident</u> at the facility on March 28, 1979. GPU Nuclear defueled the reactor vessel and decontaminated the facility and the plant is in a safe, stable condition known as post-defueling monitored storage. The formal transition of TMI-2 from post-accident cleanup to monitored storage required NRC approval, which was granted in 1993.

The meeting will be held from 7-9 p.m. in the Cocoa Terrace at Hershey Lodge, 325 University Drive, Hershey, Pa. The company submitted the <u>Post Shutdown Decommissioning Activities Report</u> on June 28, 2013.
