NRC Seeks to Fill Open Reactor Safeguards Advisory Committee Position

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission is seeking a qualified candidate for appointment to its Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards. The ACRS is an advisory group that provides independent technical review of, and advice on, matters related to the safety of existing and proposed nuclear facilities, and on the adequacy of proposed reactor safety standards. It also advises the Commission on issues in health physics and radiation protection.

For this position, a candidate must have extensive experience in nuclear power plant light water reactor severe accident behavior, accident source terms, and advanced reactor systems. Best qualified candidates must also have at least 20 years of broad experience and a distinguished record of achievement in one or more areas of nuclear science and technology or related engineering disciplines. More details can be found in the *Federal Register* notice published today and also available on the NRC website.

Consistent with the requirements of the Federal Advisory Committee Act, the Commission seeks a candidate with a diverse background, so membership on the Committee is fairly balanced in terms of the points of view and functions to be performed. Candidates will undergo a thorough security background check to obtain the security clearance that is mandatory for all ACRS members.
