## NRC Proposes \$15,000 Fine to JAN X-Ray Services for Violations of NRC Requirements

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission is proposing a \$15,000 fine to JAN X-Ray Services Inc. for violations of NRC requirements involving the failure to control and maintain surveillance of licensed radioactive material. The violations concern the company's security practices, as described in an Oct. 4 inspection <u>report</u>.

After reviewing the company's response to the proposed violations, the NRC concluded that JANX, based in Parma, Michigan, failed to meet NRC requirements while performing radiographic testing on a natural gas pipeline at a temporary job location in Ypsilanti Township, Michigan. The violations involve:

- Failure to secure a radiography camera with nuclear material from unauthorized removal;
- Failure to use a minimum of two independent physical barriers to secure a mobile device on a vehicle with radioactive material when not under the direct control of the company employees; and
- Failure to disable the vehicle from moving when not under direct control and constant surveillance by the company employees.

The company has 60 days to dispute the fine or request involvement of a neutral third-party mediator to resolve the issues.
